# St Joseph Tríduum and Table

Our St. Joseph Triduum is a special celebration in honor

of our patron saint. It will occur on March 17th, 18th, and 19th, starting at 7:00 PM in the church on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday evenings. Father Nick Rouch, our Vicar General will be our guest speaker for all three evenings. We kindly request you to mark your calendars now so that you can plan to attend this important event.



The Feast of St. Joseph which always falls in the middle of Lent is Tuesday, March 19<sup>th</sup>. This Feast Day is especially celebrated in Italy where St. Joseph has been long regarded as the island's Patron saint. It is there that the tradition of the St. Joseph Table (Altar) began. March 19<sup>th</sup> is, in Italy, also Father's Day. Very fitting as St. Joseph was, of course, the foster father of Jesus. This is a shared celebration with the entire community where the riches of foods are given as alms to the poor. Traditional etiquette is that **no one** can be turned away from the table.

We are pleased to announce that we will be hosting a St. Joseph Table dinner on Tuesday, March 19th in the Community Center. The dinner will start at 5:30 pm and will be in honor of our Patron Saint. We will be serving soup, salad, and bread, along with a traditional St. Joseph Table. We are looking for volunteers to help us bake for this event. There will be sign-up sheets available in the vestibule of the church starting this weekend. We have traditional dessert recipes for this celebration, and we also encourage you to bring desserts that are made for Oktoberfest.
