Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Epiphany. The word "Epiphany" is another word for revelation. What God reveals about Himself today is that He is the God for ALL people, not just for the Jewish people. This is why our Church is called "catholic". Catholic means universal and it means that it is for everyone. Is my will the same as God's will in this regard? Do we believe that God wants everyone to be saved and do we want everyone to be saved? If so what are we doing about it?

As the Kings gave gifts to Jesus, so I also want to thank everyone for all the many personal gifts to me for Christmas! As pastor I really appreciate that people take the time to write me a note or get me a thoughtful gift or money that I can use. This year especially, it meant the world to me! As I do every year, I need to remind everyone that we need to make sure everyone is aware that the hospitals and nursing homes are becoming more and more strict about releasing the names of people who are in the hospital. We used to be able call the hospitals and give them a code and get the names of all our parishioners that were in the hospital or nursing home. This is getting more and more difficult since some hospitals have even stopped asking what religion you are, or what parish you belong to! This is because of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) privacy laws. So, you MUST call the office and let us know if you or a member of the parish is going to be in the hospital and how long they are going to stay and what room they are in. Also, if you are going to have serious surgery or you have been diagnosed with a serious illness call and ask to be anointed and I will anoint you!

Let us keep our eyes on Jesus this year, like the eyes of a servant on his master, let our one desire be to please Him in all things! Let us always pray for each other and remember that I love you! God Bless+++




#### <u>GIFTS TO JESUS</u>
