#### Praised Be Jesus Christ!

Once again, I want to congratulate all those from our parish that received Confirmation last week at the Cathedral! I am so proud of all of you! Know that we are praying for you to grow more and more in love with Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit! I would encourage you all now to get involved in various ministries in the church – we NEED you!

Next, as we talked about last week, we now have a plan to move forward for the future with our parish. Again, the plan is on July 9, 2024 (which is a Tuesday – I have NO IDEA why) - we will partner with Sacred Heart Church and will include St. Paul's. St. Paul's will be merged into Sacred Heart. Sacred Heart and St. Joe's BOL will both continue to be their own parishes but will have one pastor. The parish offices will be combined into one office at whatever place will be best. details will come later. Each parish will continue to have their own finance council but, will have a leadership (parish) council that consists of equal members from St Joe's, Sacred Heart, and St Paul's. We will all work together with staying separate parishes. There are many things that still have to be worked out, that is why we have all this time before it officially starts. I have NO IDEA when this will happen, but I am hoping and praying it will happen as soon as possible. As I told you, I have asked to stay here and be the pastor of both parishes, but that is up to the personal board and ultimately Bishop Perscio. So, pray God's Holy Will be done!
