Praised Be Jesus Christ!

March has been here – that means spring is just around the corner – even though it has not been a very bad winter, well part of it anyway: it is great to know that soon everything will be blooming! This of course is a great symbol for Lent and Easter, though we are in the midst of penance and self-denial, God reminds us that Easter is coming. 




