

#### Praised Be Jesus Christ!

Happy Lent! As we have begun our Lenten Journey with Jesus this needs to be an encounter with Jesus and a transformation into Him! This transformation must involve our being crucified with Jesus so that we may rise with Him when we celebrate Easter.

We heard this past Ash Wednesday in the opening reading: "Even now, says the LORD, return to me with your whole heart, with fasting, and weeping, and mourning; Rend your hearts, not your garments, and return to the LORD, your God" Joel 2:12 God calls us into a deeper relationship with Him and this relationship calls us to grow in holiness. Notice that I said "grow" in holiness! If I asked you, "Are you a good person?" you would probably say, "Oh yes, Father," and that is great. However, the real question is: "Are you a holy person?" and the answer must also be "Yes, Father," because God has set you apart for Him. That is what Holiness is - to be set apart for God! YOU have been chosen by God, set apart for God as a beloved son or daughter of the Father; but you need to grow in this, and Lent helps us to do just that.

We also hear in today's Gospel: "The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and He remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan." Mark 1:12 Jesus entered into His "lent" filled with The Holy Spirit and led by the Holy Spirit. Do we really think that our acts of self-denial and the extra things that we may do can have any effect in our lives unless it is guided by the Holy Spirit? If Jesus, who is the God of the Universe, needed in His Humanity the Holy Spirit to deal with temptation how much more do we need Him? I would encourage you that if you do not have a daily prayer of surrender to the Holy Spirit that you start one this very day! Let His Spirit lead you this Lent and you will grow in Holiness and grow in love of Him and others!




